First 10 Days

- Mercy of Allah (Rahmah)

What to do:

- neighbours if you can do their shopping for them.

- Be kind and courteous Give small gifts to your nieces/nephews or small kids in the extended family and in return ask them to include you in their duas. Allah always accepts the duas of masoom / 2) Forgive yourself and have young children

Second 10 Days

- Forgiveness of Allah (Maghfirah)

What to do:

- Help those around you Ask elderly 1) Forgive people who have hurt you - We often hurt people without even being aware of it. We err often too and want the forgiveness of Allah. Let this month be one where we forgive those who have hurt us and soften our hearts for the sake of Allah. In turn, those we have hurt may forgive us Insha-Allah and Allah will forgive our misgivings too.

Translation: O Allah, You are Forgiving and love forgiveness, so forgive me" or "O Allah, You are Pardoning and love to pardon, so pardon me.

اللَّهُمَّ أَجِرْنِي مِنَ النَّارِ :Arabic

English: Allahuma Ajirni minan

Translation: O Allah, save me from the fire (Jahannam).
